

Health & Safety Policy - Statement of intent

The Company recognises its duty under Section 2 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, and commits itself to implementing the provisions contained therein. It will, so far as is reasonably practicable, ensure the health, safety and welfare of the Company's employees and the health and safety of others who may be affected by its operations, including customers personnel, contractors, visitors and the general public.

The company will:

- Make adequate provision to protect the health and safety of its employees at work and of other persons.
- Maintain the quality of the environment.
- Avoid injury to the public or any damage to property as a result of Company activities.
- Ensure that employees and others at all levels exercise a Duty of Care, co-operate in establishing and maintaining safety and healthy working conditions and avoid any action which may be detrimental to the health and safety of themselves or others or which would adversely affect the environment.
- Provide adequate where possible, supervision, information and training for all its employees and contractors.
- Strive to ensure sure high standards of health and safety and the quality of the environment are maintained.
- Enlist and encourage the co-operation of every employee and others in all matters appertaining to health and safety.
- Operate safe systems of work.
- Operate plant, vehicles and equipment that are properly designed and adequately inspected and maintained.
- Safely analyse, treat and disposing of wastes.
- The company will fully comply with the provisions of Duty of Care in the way it imports, produces, carries, recycles, treats or disposes of all wastes in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1990.
